**CIB W122 – Public Private Partnership
Invitation Call for Papers
CIB World Congress, 17-21 June 2019, Hong Kong**



PPP researchers and practitioners are invited to submit papers for the CIB World Building Congress, themed 'Constructing Smart Cities' that will take place in Hong Kong, China next year, 17 –21 June, 2019.

The W122 - Public Private Partnership is grouped under Sub-theme 6: Smart Government, Policy and Economy.

As identified in our PPP roadmap, the research in PPP is continually emerging and has been switched from a pure construction and built asset focus to a wider perspective including topics from finance, law, public administration, construction and built asset management.

As a result, we have also identified areas of development strategy for PPP where a research and development agenda are needed in a number of areas as categorised in the following themes.

- Theme 1: Financing, and financial models and structure
- Theme 2: Risk allocation and management
- Theme 3: Transparency and Accountability including regulatory and institutional frameworks
- Theme 4: Public Policy and Private/Public Sector behaviours
- Theme 5: PPP Project Evaluation
- Theme 6: Contractual structure
- Theme 7: PPP performance indicators

This forthcoming congress in Hong Kong will enable us to debate and discuss these themes. You are encouraged to submit papers that cover any of the themes or a combination of the themes, or indeed any other important emerging themes.

This will be an opportunity to continue to build and consolidate our knowledge in state of the art developments in PPP. The process for submitting abstracts for the conference can be found at the WBC website: <http://www.wbc2019.hk>.
